



## ADMISSIONS POLICY

Woodcrest Academy is an English medium school with Afrikaans taught as the 1<sup>st</sup> additional language and IsiZulu as the 2<sup>nd</sup> additional language. The major criterion for admission to the school is the applicant's fluency in English. This criterion ensures that the applicant will not be disadvantaged or negatively affect the pace of learning in the classroom.

The interview process for enrolment includes an admission test. Should the applicant not meet the required level of English fluency in this test, admission will be postponed until such time as they have improved sufficiently to meet this criterion.

Admission will be at the discretion of the Principal following a formal interview with the child and parents or guardian. The Principal will ascertain the capacity of the applicant to follow a mainstream curriculum before admitting the applicant into the school. The Principal will advise the parent or guardian as to the appropriate enrolment grade for the child based on her assessment.

Admission is also subject to the person responsible for the payment of school fees passing a credit check carried out by our credit bureau.

The school has limited capacity to assist learners with serious physical impairments and does not cater for learners who are unable to cope with a mainstream education programme.

At the end of each year, parents are required to apply for re-enrolment of their child for the following year. Acceptance for re-enrolment is at the discretion of the Principal based on financial and behavioural patterns.
